**ADVANCED REFINING CONCEPTS AWARDED CONTRACT
TO PROVIDE CLEAN *GDIESEL*[®] FUEL TO CLARK COUNTY, NEV.**

RENO, Nev. – January 20, 2011 – Advanced Refining Concepts, LLC, (ARC), a privately held developer and manufacturer of proprietary motor and industrial fuels, today announced that it has been awarded a one-year contract to supply approximately one million gallons of its clean *GDiesel*[®] fuel to Clark County, located in Southern Nevada. *GDiesel*[®], designated by the Nevada Division of Environmental Protection (NDEP) as an alternative fuel, will be used to power the county’s diesel vehicle fleet and generators.

“*GDiesel*[®] is the cleanest-burning diesel fuel that we have been able to find and requires no modifications to our vehicles or equipment,” said David Johnson, manager of Clark County’s Automotive Division.

“We operate the third largest vehicle fleet in the state of Nevada, and the use of this new fuel allows us to lower emissions and still save on fuel costs.”

“This contract represents a great opportunity for our company, while at the same time lowering fuel costs and improving the air quality for the people in Clark County,” said Peter Gunnerman, co-founder and director of Advanced Refining Concepts. “The significant volumes of fuel used by county vehicles and generators during the term of the contract will be a cornerstone for the new construction of a zero emissions *GDiesel*[®] refinery in Clark County during 2011.”

In December, the Clark County Commission approved the contract as part of the county’s ongoing energy conservation efforts. The county’s Automotive Services Division tested *GDiesel*[®] in various vehicles, including county vehicles operated at McCarran International Airport, and found significant reductions in common air pollutants.

By state law, 90% of the vehicles counties and local governments acquire each year are required to use alternative fuel. Clark County exceeds that standard. Emergency response vehicles such as fire trucks are exempt from that requirement. However, the county will begin using *GDiesel*[®] in fire department vehicles this year. The majority of Clark County’s fleet is powered by alternative fuels. Of its 2,798 vehicles and equipment, 1,426 are diesel powered, most of which will now run on *GDiesel*[®].

To produce *GDiesel*[®], ARC utilizes the proprietary *ClearRefining*[™] process, which allows for pollution-free and cost-effective conversion of natural gas and other biogases into ultra clean liquid motor and industrial fuels. *ClearRefining*[™] is a safe and efficient low temperature, low pressure closed-loop catalytic process.
